

Manchester man arrested for three robberies

Multiple charges:

Police arrested Henry Bellemare, 47, for three robberies and a theft this week in Manchester.

MANCHESTER — Police believe they have solved three robberies and a theft, which occurred over a four-day period this week, with the arrest of Henry Bellemare, 47.

The Subway at 1000 Elm St. was robbed Tuesday and the Ben and Jerry's store on Elm Street and the Subway at 20 S. Main St., were robbed Wednesday.

Thursday, Police arrested Henry Bellemare, 47, for the Tuesday and Wednesday Subway robberies, the Wednesday Ben and Jerry's robbery and a Monday theft from the CVS store on Elm Street.

Police said in the Wednesday robberies the robber claimed to have a weapon, but none was shown. In each incident, the robber fled with an undisclosed amount of cash.

Surveillance video aided police in identifying Bellemare, who was described in each incident as wearing sweatpants and sweatshirt, having gray hair and facial hair.

Bellemare, who has no fixed address, is scheduled for arraignment Friday in Circuit Court-Manchester District Division on three felony robbery charges and a misdemeanor theft by unauthorized taking charge.
