On 11-25-07 at approx. 1900 hrs Ofc Ruppel and Ofc Landry responded to a report

of a domestic Dispute at 6 Kendall Pond Rd.

Upon arrival Ofc Ruppel met with Tina Carter in the driveway who stated that her son, Andrew Carter, and his wife, Nicola Dean, had been involved in a Domestic Dispute approx. 10-15minutes earlier. Tina stated that (Andrew) Carter had left the residence approx. 5-10minutes prior to DPD's arrival with his girlfriend Tina Troy. Ofc Ruppel proceeded inside to speak with Dean, her 3 year old daughter Brooke Carter and (Andrew) Carter's father Stuart Carter.

Once inside Ofc. Ruppel observed that *the residence appeared to have been recently damaged with plaster on the floor from holes in the walls and doors torn from the hinges laying throughout the residence_(pictures taken)*. Dean stated that the residence belonged to her and Carter but that Carter had moved out a few weeks ago because they had separated in anticipation of a divorce. Dean stated that Carter had moved into an apartment in Londonderry with his girlfriend Tina Troy. Dean gave the following account. On 11-25-07 at approx. 1500hrs Dean, Brooke and Troy went out to lunch together, with Carter's approval, because they wanted Brooke to meet Troy. The lunch went well and Tina Troy invited Dean and Brooke back to her and Carter's apartment in Londonderry so Dean could see where Brooke would be staying when she was with her father. When they arrived at the apartment Carter was there with some of his unidentified friends.

While at the apartment Carter gave Dean a "quick kiss" Carter did not know if Troy witnessed the kiss but observed that immediately after the kiss Troy appeared agitated. A few minutes later Dean could hear Troy and Carter arguing. Dean went to investigate and observed Troy slapping Carter on his arms and face. To prevent Troy from slapping him, Carter was holding Troy's arms down by her sides. As Troy began to work her arms free, *Carter placed his hand around Troy's throat and began to choke her*. Dean approached Carter and told him to stop. *Carter slapped Dean on the left side of her face with his open hand* and told her to mind her own business. Carter then let go of Troy. Dean walked outside and Troy flowed her. Carter came out a few minutes later and threw Troy's purse into the backyard causing Troy's car keys and eye glasses to spill out into the woods. Dean and Troy proceeded into the backyard to look for Troy's belongings. Dean invited Troy back to her house a 6 Kendall Pond to give Carter time to calm down. As Dean, Brooke and Troy got into Dean's vehicle they observed Carter get into his vehicle and drive away but they did not know where he was going.

Dean, Brooke and Troy arrived at Dean's residence at approximately 1830hrs and went inside. Dean went into her bedroom to draw the shades and observed Carter laying on the floor next to her bed apparently trying to hide from Dean. Dean later guessed that Carter had come to the house to get their Checkbooks and leave before Dean arrived home not expecting Dean to get home so quickly. Dean also noted that Carter must have purposely parked in a hidden spot because his car was not in the driveway when she arrived home or anywhere in sight. Dean asked Carter what he was doing. Carter stood up and stated "you ruined my fucking life" and slapped Dean on the left side of her face with his open hand. Carter then exited the bedroom and proceeded to damage items throughout the residence such as a crock pot, computer printer, closet doors, walls, ceilings, plates, and a desk while Dean, Brooke and Troy watched. Carter then went outside onto the front steps of the residence where Troy joined him. Dean looked outside to make sure Troy was all right at which point Carter stated "I'll never see you or my child again" and got in his truck. Troy voluntarily got into the passenger seat of the truck and they drove away. Dean called Tina Carter to inform her of the incident. Tina and Stuart Carter immediately drove to the residence and called DPD. Written Statement obtained (28344)

Ofc. Ruppel did not observe any marks on Dean's face (pictures taken). Ofc. Ruppel asked Dean how hard Carter had struck her. Dean stated that Carter did not strike her as hard as he could have but that he did hit her hard enough to cause her to place her hand on the wall to stop from falling down. Ofc. Ruppel asked Dean if any

of the items that Carter had taken belonged to her. Dean stated that most of the items belonged to both her and Dean as a married couple but that the crock pot and dishes had been given to her as a gift. Ofc Ruppel asked Dean if Carter owned any weapons. Dean stated that Carter owned a rifle but that he had taken it with him when he moved out a few weeks earlier. Tina Carter added that she believed that Carter also owned a handgun. Dean stated that she was unaware of Carter owning a handgun.

Ofc Landry advised Ofc Ruppel that **Brooke Carter had stated "daddy smacked mommy two times"** (see Ofc Landry's Supplemental Narrative). **Tina Carter told Ofc Ruppel that she wanted Carter arrested because he "had quite a temper" and needed to be arrested.**

Ofc. Ruppel *advised dispatch to have Londonderry PD look for Carter, who was possibly armed, at his apartment on Harvey Rd and arrest him* on a 12 hour Domestic related Simple Assault and to check the welfare of Troy.

Ofc Landry advised Dean of her Domestic Violence rights and how to get a Restraining Order (RO) against Carter. Ofc Ruppel advised Dean that she could go to DPD to request an Emergency Restraining Order to prohibit Carter from contacting her until she got the RO but that it would not be in effect until it was physically handed to Carter. Ofc Ruppel explained that if Carter was located he would be arrested and that part of his bail conditions would be a no contact order meaning that without an ERO Carter would not be allowed to contact her. Dean stated that she understood and that she did not want to get an ERO and that she would go to Derry District Court the following day to get a Restraining Order.

Ofc Ruppel advised Dean that until Carter was located that she and Brooke should probably stay elsewhere in case Carter returned home. Dean agreed and collected belongings for herself and Brooke while Ofc Ruppel and Ofc Landry stood by. Tina Carter took Brooke with her and Ofc Landry escorted Dean to her friends house on Franklin St in Derry.

At approximately 2015hrs Ofc Ruppel was advised that Londonderry PD had Carter in custody and that he would be transported to DPD (see07-1299-AR). Ofc Ruppel contacted Dean and advised her of Carter's arrest. (28345)

Brooke told Landry that "Daddy smacked Mommy two times" When Brooke demonstrated, she swung her open hand across the air in front of her face. Brooke went on to say that Daddy threw everything around the house and caused a mess. Ofc. Ruppel obtained a digital camera from his cruiser and documented the scene with photographs. Landry noted that in the kitchen, there was a broken door, broken crock pot, glass all over the floor and a couple of holes in the walls. In the hallway to the bedroom there was a broken computer printer, holes in the walls/ceiling and drops of blood on the walls. Nichola said that the blood was from Andrew's hands when he was punching and hitting everything. The master bedroom was completely trashed including holes in the walls and the dresser drawers thrown all over the bed and floor. The computer room door was smashed and the desk was dented.

Once at DPDHQ Landry read Andrew his Miranda rights which he refused to sign. (28350)

A police prosecutor Monday won an increase in bail from the \$15,000 cash/surety set by a bail commissioner to \$25,000 cash/surety for a man accused of second-degree assault and other charges from an incident Friday.

Andrew Carter, 33, of 945 Mammoth Road, Manchester, NH, could enter no plea to the felony charge that accuses him of grabbing his girlfriend around the neck with his right hand, impeding her ability to breathe. A probable cause hearing was set for May 11. Carter pleaded innocent to six misdemeanor charges that accuse him of assault, for knocking her to the floor, wrapping his arms around her and refusing to release her and headbutting her in the forehead; criminal threatening, for telling her he would kill her and beat her; obstructing the report of a crime; for taking her cell phone and removing the battery; and false imprisonment, for confining her to the apartment and blocking her exit.

Police prosecutor Steven Mangone said that although Carter is out on bail on Massachusetts drug charges, having had a suppression hearing Friday, when the bail commissioner asked Carter if was out on bail, he said: "No." Asked why he didn't report that, Carter responded: "I didn't even think about it." A probable cause hearing on the felony was set for May 11 and trial on the remaining charges was set for July 26.
